



Dear Parents,

We are very excited for your child's upcoming trip to Young Life's Lost Canyon and wanted to take a moment to help you and your child prepare for a safe and exciting trip. Please take special care to fill out your child's health form; being sure to note specific *prescription* medications that your child is currently taking and should continue to take at camp. Medications that are *not* to be continued at camp should not be listed on the health form.

We value the health and safety of all guests attending camp, and therefore adhere to Young Life's requirement that all medications will be stored in the camp infirmary and taken under the supervision of the camp medical staff. The Infirmary will have regularly scheduled hours every day before and after each meal. If your child has a different medication regimen we will be happy to make arrangements to accommodate them.

To help with the registration process, we ask that you place all medications in their original prescription bottles in a zip lock bag and label with your child's name. Please hand in these medications to the leader or area staff person at the bus. We will not collect emergency medications such as EpiPens and Albuterol inhalers.

The camp is staffed with a volunteer physician and full medical team to care for guests during their stay at camp. Regarding over-the-counter medications such as Advil, Tylenol, allergy and cold medications, the camp infirmary is well stocked and able to accommodate those needs of your child.
